- First day of school is Wednesday, August 19th with an 11:00 dismissal. Thursday and Friday are full days.

Our back to school night for 2nd grade will be a **google meet on Monday, August 17th at 6:30pm**. Be on the lookout for the google meet invite the day before. Then on Monday, gather around the computer with your child, as we share some welcoming smiles.
